# Ensuring that sustainability goes handin-hand with social equity & justice

Each facet of sustainable urban development needs to be just, ensuring equitable access to our limited resources, and 'leaving no one behind'. This is critical for a number of reasons, including to gain community support and acceptance. It thus follows that transitions towards sustainable cities must be governed and organised with justice always at the forefront.

ICLEI Europe supports cities to integrate social equity and justice across their plans and policies. This includes working with local leaders to consider equity and social justice across all sectors through the development and implementation of Local Green Deals.



ICLEI aims to work with our vast network of local leaders to ensure that phasing out fossil fuels and reducing the consumption of natural resources is organised in a just and equitable way for all.

We support cities to develop and implement Local Green Deals, which help speed-up integration of social equity and justice into cross-sectoral plans and policies. This includes fostering the skills and capacities needed to usher-in just transition locally.

Zooming in on specific sectors, ICLEI works to ensure that energy transition is driven by communities, is just for all, and fights energy poverty. Its longstanding sustainable procurement network trains public buyers to leverage their procurement of goods and services so that these purchases contribute to socially-responsible supply chains.
